

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your inquiry regarding the Graduate Program in Pathobiology at Johns Hopkins. We are very much interested in attracting talented students from other countries to our program. However, there are some financial issues that limit our ability to support students who are not citizens or permanent residents of the United States. Our graduate program is funded largely by a training grant from the United States Government. This grant will only support US citizens or permanent residents. Very rarely do we obtain funds that can be used to support citizens of other countries. There are, of course, other possible means of supporting the cost of graduate study. The estimated annual expenses of a graduate student in this program (including living expenses and tuition - please see Page 2) are approximately \$69,520.00. Support could come from:

- (a) A scholarship from your past or current institution, your government, or an international organization, (such as the World Health Organization)
- (b) A foundation award (such as Rockefeller or Howard Hughes)

In your application, please discuss your plans for obtaining support from one of these sources. Final admission to the program requires some documentation that adequate and appropriate financial resources are available.
