Day Observed	More Information
<b>NATIONAL AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE MONTH</b>	Celebrates and honors the history and culture of Native Americans in the United States.
<b>NOV 1: ALL SAINTS' DAY</b>	Commemorates all known and unknown Christian saints. Eastern Christianity observes it on the first Sunday after Pentecost. (Western Christian)
<b>NOV 2: ALL SOULS' DAY</b>	Commemoration of all faithful Christians who are now dead. In Mexican tradition it is celebrated as Dia de los Muertos between October 31 and November 2, and is an occasion to remember dead ancestors and celebrate the continuity of life. (Christian)
<b>NOV 4: GURU NANAK DEV JI'S BIRTHDAY</b>	A very important holiday in the Sikh faith as Guru Nanak Dev was the First Guru of the Sikhs and the Founder of Sikhism. He was born in mid-November; the holiday is celebrated according to the lunar date. (Sikh)
<b>NOV 7: ELECTION DAY</b>	A day set by U.S. law for the election of public officials.
<b>NOV 9: KRISTALLNACHT</b>	Commemorates the 1938 pogrom against Jews throughout Germany and Vienna.
<b>NOV 11: VETERAN'S DAY</b>	Honors the U. S. Armed Services and commemorates the war dead.
<b>NOV 12: BIRTH OF BAHÁ'U'LLÁH</b>	Observance of the anniversary of the birth in 1817 of Bahá'uláh, prophet-founder of the Bahá'í Faith, in Núr, Persia.
<b>NOV 12 – NOV 18: AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK</b>	Celebrates public education and honors individuals who are making a difference in ensuring every child in the U. S. receives a quality education.
<b>NOV 16: INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR TOLERANCE</b>	Emphasizes the dangers of intolerance and is a call to action for the advancement of human welfare, freedom and progress everywhere, as well as a day to encourage tolerance, respect, dialogue and cooperation among different cultures and peoples.
<b>NOV 20: TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE</b>	Memorializes those who were killed due to anti-transgender hatred or prejudice.
<b>NOV 23: THANKSGIVING DAY</b>	Following a 19th century tradition, it commemorates the Pilgrims' harvest feast in the autumn of 1621.
<b>NOV 26: DAY OF THE COVENANT</b>	Day of the Covenant is a festival observed to commemorate Bahá'u'lláh's appointment of His son, Abdu'l-Baha, as His successor.
<b>NOV 30 – DEC 1: EID MILAD UN-NABI (MAWLID)</b>	Traditional commemoration of the birth of Muhammad. (Islam)
