Thank you for your inquiry regarding the Graduate Program in Pathobiology at Johns Hopkins. We are very much interested in attracting talented students from other countries to our program. However, we do caution applicants that the admissions process is highly competitive for both US citizens and foreign residents. Regardless of country of origin, we require all incoming students to have financial support from our program or another institutional source. The estimated annual expenses of a graduate student in this program for **2024-2025** (including living expenses, tuition, health care and other fees) are approximately **\$116,700**. Funding from the Program itself is very limited, but support could also come from:

- a) A scholarship from your past or current institution, your government, or an international organization, (such as the World Health Organization)
- b) A foundation award (such as Rockefeller or Howard Hughes)

In your application, please discuss your plans for obtaining support from one of these sources. Final admission to the program requires some documentation verifying that adequate and appropriate financial resources are available.
